

Bradys' Chronological Timeline

- 1895: Commenced operations as a Trading firm in Bruce Street, Mumbai
- 1900: Founded the first Textile Dying plant in India
- 1902: Opened a Branch Office in Manchester, United Kingdom
- 1905: Started the first Insurance Company in India
- 1907: Marketed the first Diesel Engine in India
- 1907: Collaborated to set up India's first Textile Mill
- 1918: Started India's first petrol engine driven tram under the aegis of Nasik Tramway Co.
- 1920: Constructed Brady Flats, ten identical three storey flats, in Colaba, Mumbai. This locality is not recognised as a heritage site
- 1935: Amongst one of the first Indian corporate to donate to the Indian National Congress for the freedom movement
- 1942: Founded India's largest Automated Sugar Factory at Belapur
- 1962: Accomplished becoming India's largest Indenting House for imported machineries and equipments.
